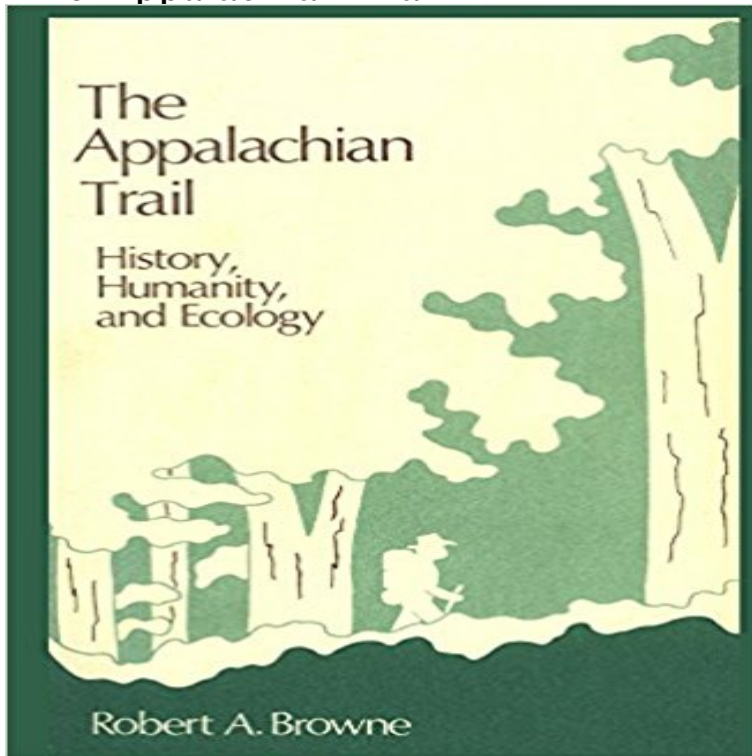


The Appalachian Trail
